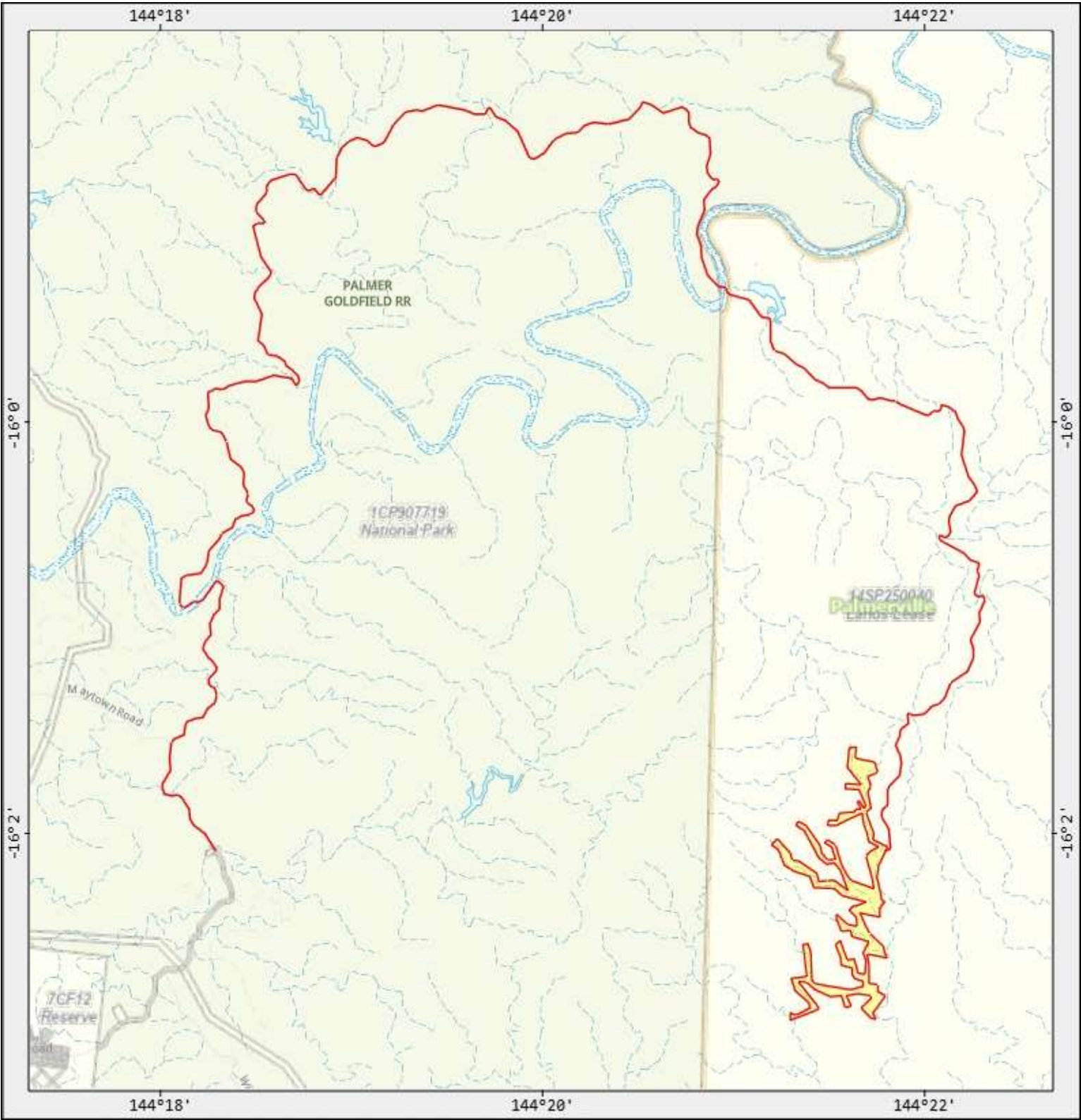

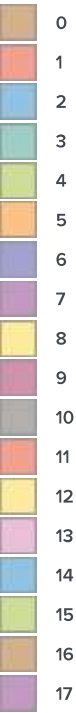

MINING LEASE WORK PROGRAM

When is mining going to start?

Work is proposed to commence following work as soon as practical following grant.

Permit Term Justification:

A term of 15 years is applied for to allow for the completion of production for already granted permits and the commencement and working of this permit and other applications made in December 2025 and January 2026. This permit is likely to commence around the same time as ML 100516 (once granted) and following the finalisation of the northern most leases.

Permit Size and Shape (attach maps):

An area of 55.01 hectares is applied for with this application. This area is undertaken as an extension to the North Palmer River project leases. The size and shape of the mining lease take in alluvial resources, terraces and provision for transport corridors. The shape of the permit allows for this application to join ML 100516 at multiple points to allow for flow of work without having additional roads constructed off-lease.

Minerals Sought:

Gold

Other Purposes Sought:

Processing Plant, water supply

Mineralisation/Tonnes/Banked cubic metres (BCM); Grade:

Approximately 8.8km of gullies/alluvial channels are applied for in this mining lease. The depth of the wash provides for approximately 52,000m³ of alluvial wash located in the area of the North Palmer River under application. Additional resources are likely to be located in the eluvial terraces outside of the river.

Mining Methodology:

Mining is by semi-mobile plant. Trommel. Material is carted from the river to the plant site for processing and returned to the river from there. Excavator is used to extract wash, dump truck takes the material to the plant, a second excavator feeds the plant.

The plant is capable of processing 80t an hour of wash without losing gold. The wash put through is variable but work on the remaining leases is anticipated to be finished in around 3 years. Rehabilitation monitoring will occur for the remainder of the term.

MINING LEASE WORK PROGRAM

Minimum Mining Rate (tonnes or BCM per hrs/days/years):

The plant is capable of processing 80t an hour of wash without losing gold. The daily wash throughput is variable depending on the quality of the wash and other determining factors.

Infrastructure:

A purpose for camp is applied for to allow for a day camp, or future camp location if all other permits are finalised prior to this one.

Plant/Equipment:

extensive machinery and equipment for use in their road contracts which can be called upon as necessary.

Mine Closure/Rehabilitation:

Rehabilitation is progressive as work moves through the river. The wet season each year aids in recontouring. Rehabilitation is planned to be finalised by the time the permits expire.

Project Considerations

Other Permits in Project/Related Leases:

ML 40079, ML 3076, ML 3077, ML 6719 are current granted leases. ML 40079 is an infrastructure lease being retained for the water storage on site.

ML 100497 was applied for on 19 December 2025 to cover the off-lease camp. ML100499, 100501 and 100503 were applied for in the following days. ML 100516 was applied for in early January. We anticipate grant of these leases around the same time as this application.

Project production (projected per annum/life):

The project production is projected to be approximately 40,000m³ each year when weather and access permits.

Human resources committed to the project:

The operation is ideally a 2 person operation, however it has been working successfully as a 1 person operation for the last couple of years. There are positive relationships with neighbouring permit holders, and on occasion they assist as needed.

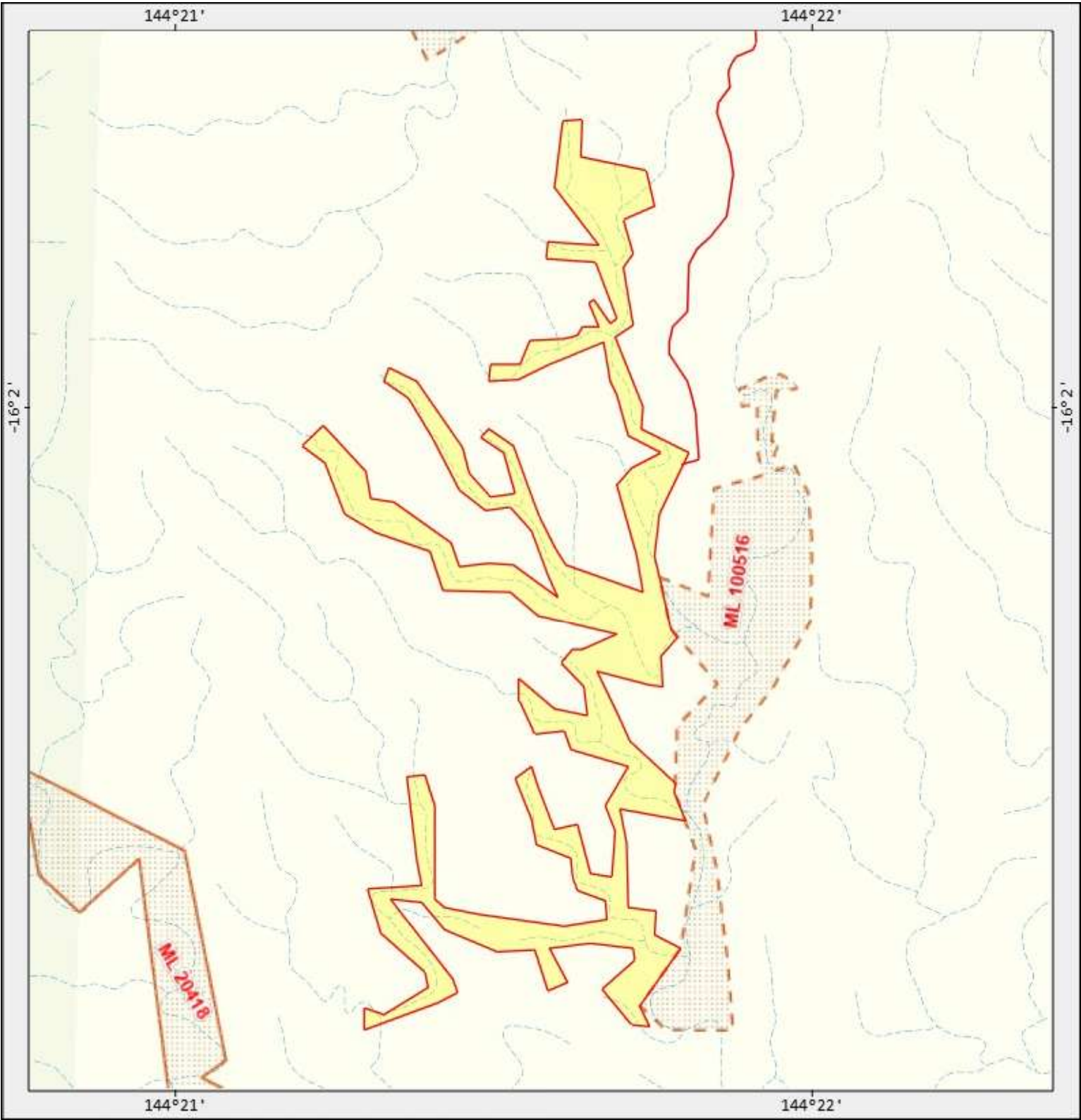

As discussed today, we will await the lodgement of varied access descriptions for MLs [REDACTED] and 100519.

For the assessments of War (NQ) Pty Ltd ML applications MLs [REDACTED] and 100519, it was identified that the access descriptions provided at lodgement are not suitable to enable ML applications to progress. The accesses traverse through the Palmer Goldfield Resources Reserve (PGRR), and QPWS will not provide a compensation agreement for access only as they deem it to be against the management principles under the *Nature Conservation Act 1992* for a reserve to be used as a 'driveway' to a resource authority located on a separate lot on plan.

Once the varied access descriptions are lodged for MLs [REDACTED] 100519 we will also need to review and re-confirm compensation requirements for each ML.

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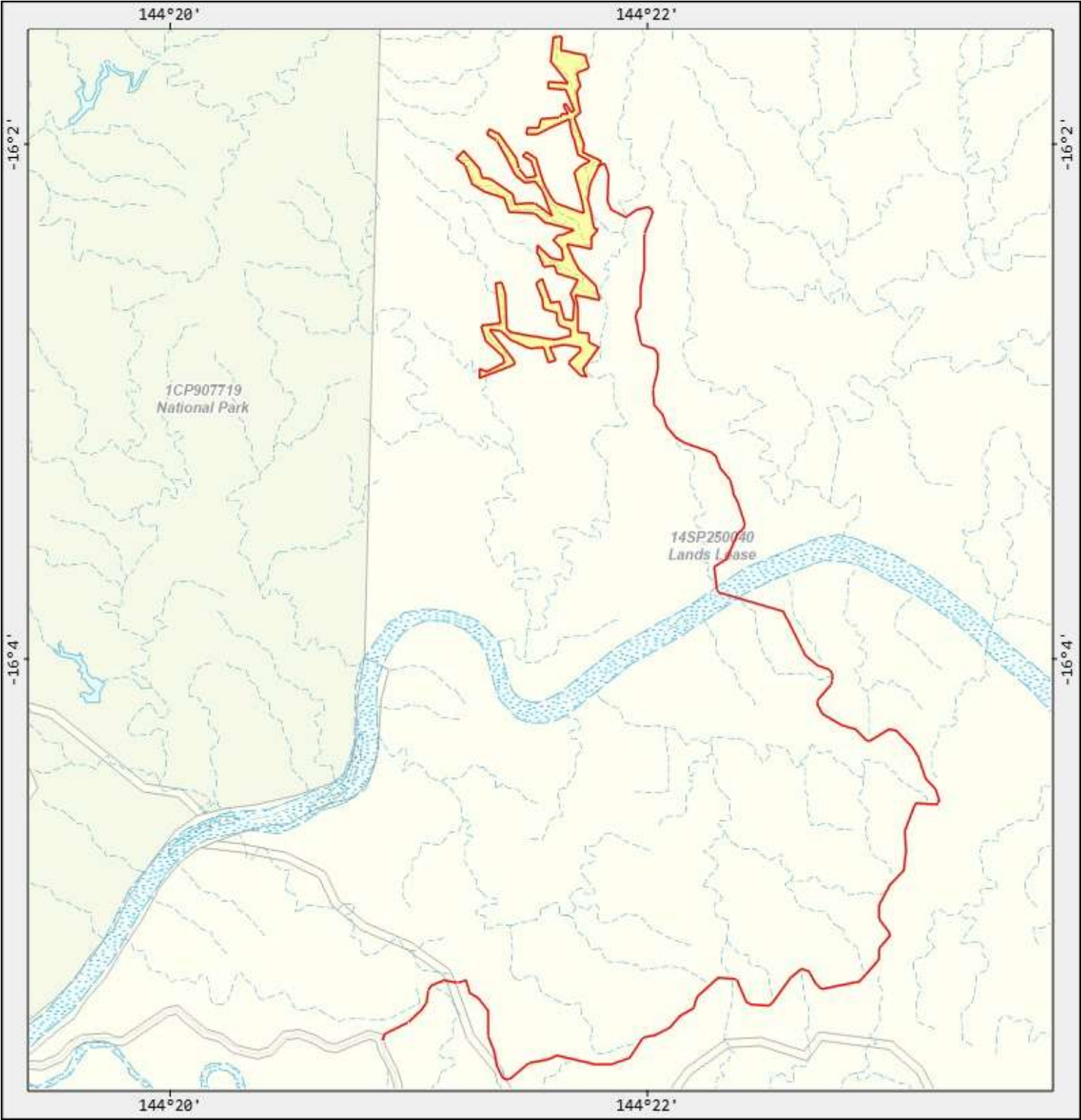

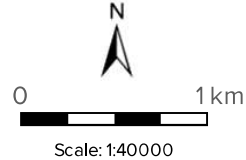
